

THE VILLAGE CLUB OF SANDS POINT

The Village Club Commission, in conjunction with the Golf Committee and Professional Staff, has implemented some rules and policies to enable every member and guest have a pleasant experience at the Village Club of Sands Point while maintaining first class course conditions. These policies and procedures are effective as of March 3, 2015.

First Offense: Verbal and/or written warning

Second Offense: Suspension of all golf privileges for seven days

Third Offense: Meeting with grievance committee regarding permanent loss of golf privileges

Golf Cart Rules

General Golf Cart Rules

- **Golf cart operators must obey all golf cart and traffic signs including directional stakes**
 - **Golf carts must be kept on the cart paths near tee boxes and putting greens**
 - **Golf carts must exit to the cart paths and shall be no closer than thirty (30) yards from any putting green**

Disability Bag Tag Rules

- **Golf carts must be parked no closer than thirty (30) feet from any green**
 - **Golf carts must be kept on the cart paths near tee boxes**
 - **Golf carts must obey any directional signs and stakes including “cart path only” signs on any and all holes**
 - **Golf carts shall not be driven between a green and a greenside bunker and/or a water hazard**

Dress Code

All Golf Facilities (Course, Driving Range, Chipping and Putting Greens)

Men

- **Acceptable – Shirts with collars and sleeves, mock turtle neck shirts, slacks and golf shorts**
- **Unacceptable – Tank tops, tee shirts, cut-offs, fitness clothing, jeans, bathing suits, tennis attire and shirts not tucked in**

Women

- **Acceptable – Dresses, skirts, slacks, shorts and blouses are appropriate. Sleeveless shirts with collars and collarless shirts with sleeves are permissible**
- **Unacceptable – Halter tops, tank tops, bathing suits, fitness clothing, blue denim jeans, tennis attire**

No Show Policy

One member can cancel their groups tee times, no later than 5:00pm the night before the day of play. Failure to do so will result in a \$30 no show fee to the offending player(s) in the group in addition to the infraction penalties listed above.

Driving Range

- **We have new, high-quality, range balls this year**
- **Range balls may not be removed from the driving range or practice area**

Etiquette

We expect all members to abide by generally accepted golf course etiquette. The golf professional staff will monitor etiquette and behavior and report violations to the golf committee. The list below is not meant to be comprehensive, but highlights certain key issues that arise regularly.

- **Pace of play – a round of golf for a foursome should not exceed four hours; in addition, on weekend mornings, the first few groups out should play in less than 3 ½ hours**
- **Bunkers – Bunkers must be raked immediately after play (this can be done while another player is playing her/his next shot)**
- **Ball marks – please repair your ball mark every time you reach a green; if you can't find yours or didn't make one, repair another while someone in your group is lining up to putt**
- **Divots – Either replace fairway divots that remain intact or fill them in with sand/seed provided**

As a reminder, failure to adhere to the course etiquette guidelines will result in the following penalties:

First Offense: Verbal and/or written warning by the golf staff

Second Offense: Suspension of all golf privileges for seven days

Third Offense: Meeting with grievance committee regarding loss of golf privileges
